

Camp Four Seasons Information

Camp Guidelines

1. All campers must attend & participate in all scheduled activities. (Exclusion for illness will be determined and evaluated by Director)
2. Absolutely no guys in girls cabins/showers or girls in boys cabin/showers.
3. Only campers are allowed on the campgrounds after camp begins. Any visitors who do not gain prior approval from the Director will be required to leave. Parents and visitors can register upon notification of the Camp Director or his/her designate. There is no cost to attend visit a service but there may be costs for meals or activities.
4. All campers are to attend the full week unless arrangements are made with the Director prior to beginning of camp.
5. Phone calls by campers are prohibited. (See policy statement listed later in this brochure.)
6. Dress for camp activities will be consistent with principles of Christian camping. Dress should be modest and appropriate for scheduled activity. (Please note the separate and updated Dress Policy)
7. Safety for campers will be a concern at all times. Wrestling, fighting, unscheduled activities or those not sanctioned by the Director will not be allowed.
8. Although camping encourages friendships, male/female relationships are to be consistent with modest behavior. Camp is not a place to experience or express a sensual, physical relationship. No PDA beyond casual handholding.
9. Campers are expected to treat the facilities with respect. Campers will refrain from writing on any property except in area approved by the Camp Four Seasons Board.
10. The camp cannot be responsible for camper's valuables. A "bank" *may* be provided for camper's money. Do not bring anything to valuable you can't live without it.
11. Campers are not allowed to drive personal vehicles during camp, except for arriving to and departing from camp.
12. Campers are expected to remain in their cabins from curfew until morning.

What Not To Bring

1. Consider not bringing Radios, tape/CD players, Walkman, TVs, satellite dishes, **cellular phones**, pagers, fax machines...I think that about covers it! If any of these items are lost or stolen, Four Seasons Christian Center will not be held liable.
Do **NOT** Bring...
2. Fireworks, weapons (nuclear or otherwise), matches, or lighters.
3. Alcoholic beverages, tobacco in any form, non-prescription drugs, pornographic materials. (All prescription drugs must be dispensed under the supervision of the camp nurse)
4. Whiny, critical, lazy, self-serving attitudes! Let's have some fun...what do you say!?!

Phone Policy

We are fully conscious of our great responsibility in the care of your child. In case of any emergency, either physical or otherwise, you will be notified immediately or as soon as possible. Consequently, we do not allow phone calls either incoming or outgoing because of the interruption to the schedule and the effect on camper morale (usually such a call makes homesickness worse.) This includes birthdays, and other special occasions however exceptions can be made by the Director. Please do NOT contact the camp staff for any reason other than emergency.

Responsibility

Every conceivable effort is made to protect camper health and safety through training staff, constant inspection of all equipment, and by the supervision of the campers. However, Four Seasons Christian Center assumes no responsibility for accidents, illness, or for loss of personal equipment by fire, theft, or camper carelessness. In our many years of camping, illnesses, injuries, and losses have been minimal. In very extensive surveys of camp safety, it has been determined that kids are "eight times safer in summer camps than in school."

Camp Discipline

We want camp to be a milestone in each camper's life. A time of fun and growth to be remembered for many years to come. We want it to be a very positive, fun, and faith-filled time. We believe in positive reinforcement and taking the time to teach our campers healthy values and personal disciplines. However, the Director reserves the right to dismiss any camper whose influence or conduct becomes in any way detrimental to the best interest or safety of the other members of the camp. The camper's parents will then be responsible to pick the camper up within twelve hours, without refund. We're confident that each family will understand this position and converse on this matter prior to arrival to camp.

Camp T-shirts

Camp T-shirts will be available again this year. T-shirts will sport the camp theme and logo on a, 100 % pre-shrunk cotton T-shirt, and will be available in various sizes. Cost for the shirts will be \$10 this year and may be purchased during registration or throughout the week but only as supplies last. Checks are to be made payable to "Kentucky Ministries of the Church of God".

What to Bring

1. Bed roll or sleeping bag and pillow
2. Plenty of labeled, comfortable clothing, ie; shorts, T-shirts, socks, sneakers (an extra pair would be helpful), sleepwear, etc. Include modest one-piece swimwear. (again see the Dress Policy if there's a question)
3. Be prepared for the weather and bugs...Umbrella, rain poncho, garbage bags, sunscreen, insect repellent, you get the picture!
4. Toilet Articles...towels, shower shoes, shampoo, soap, deodorant, did I say soap...please!
5. Flashlight, athletic equipment, camera, musical instruments, etc.
6. Bible, notebook, pencil, of course Teddy Bears are always cool!
7. Money: There is little need for cash at camp, but if you need to, Five or ten dollars for purchases at a camp or convenience store. (Additional \$10.00 for Camp T-shirt if desired)
8. An incredibly awesome, enthusiastic, adventurous and positive attitude.
