

The Dress Code for the Kentucky Ministries of the Church of God

Conduct Code Overview:

- Remember that we are not just representing The Church of God, Anderson Indiana, but the “church” in general so our conduct needs to be exemplary. We want to stress Modesty and be a Witness in what we wear, say and do.

Water sports area:

- No food or drinks inside the pool area.
- No running or horseplay inside the pool area.
- No one allowed in the pool without staff permission and supervision or during off hours.

Dress Code:

- No two piece or indecent bathing suits allowed at any time.
- No Short Shorts
- No bare midriffs or belly’s – shirts must meet waistbands.
- No clothing with lewd, vulgar or improper wording symbols or messages.
- No indecent exposure at any time.

Use the general **3-B, NVU rule**: 3-B’s, everyone has **B**reasts, a **B**elly and a **B**ackside, so we don’t want to see yours! **ALSO, No Visible Underwear**. These rules apply to even simple activities that require movement such as standing, sitting or bending over.

Additional notes...

Ladies, you will not be allowed to wear bikinis or two-piece swimsuits of any kind for any state watersport activities or at the camp. Also, please no spaghetti strap tops at all... dresses or tank tops with wide shoulder straps are OK. Shorts are okay but please no short shorts, gymnastic or cheerleading style shorts or hip-huggers that show your belly.

Gentlemen, no tight shorts, “Speedo” style shorts, basketball shorts or cut-offs. Please wear suits intended for the pool or beach where appropriate. Also, please no frayed jeans or clothing that is too large and falls off the body. Please wear a belt and keep the color and style of your underwear to yourselves.
